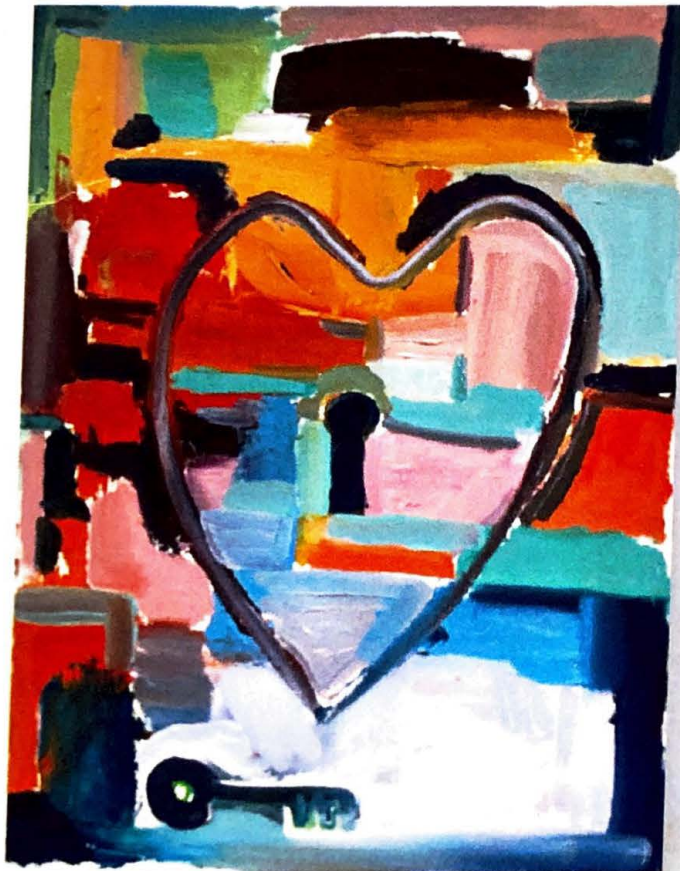

Ekaterini Koliakou – About the Artist

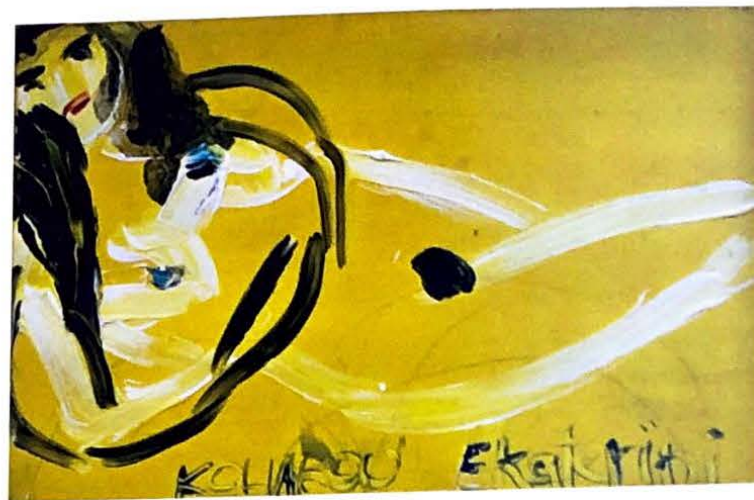

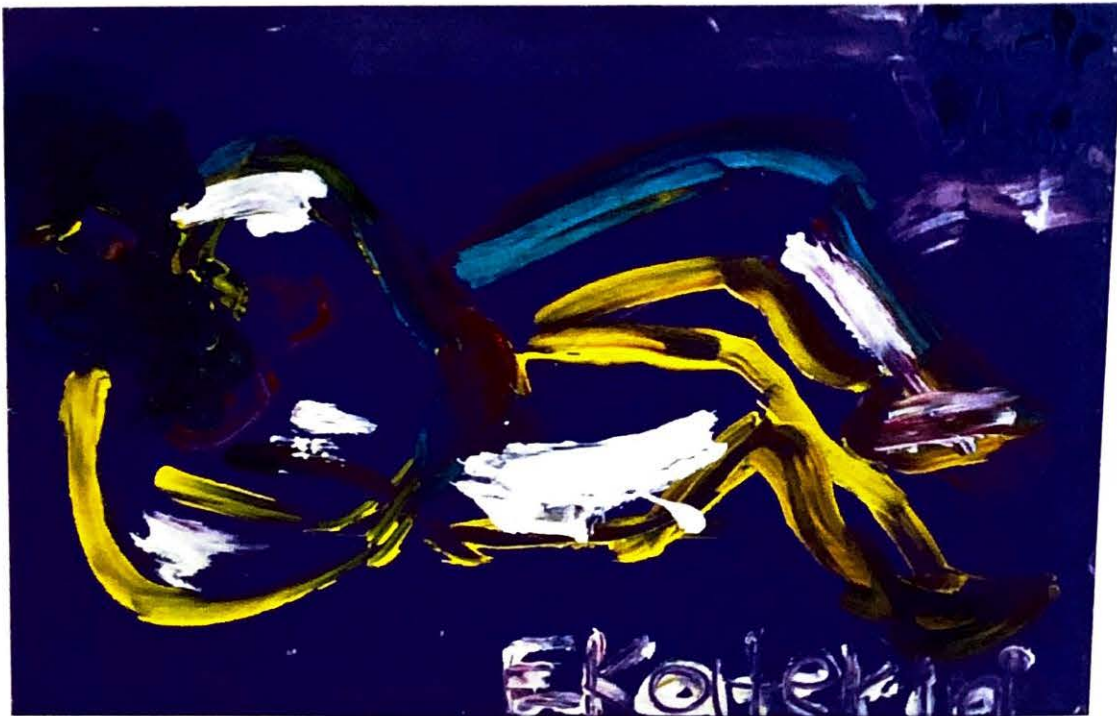
